### **Guidelines for reporting**

1. All students will submit duly signed self undertaking/consent form in view of covid 19 pandemic
2. All students will submit parent's consent/undertaking/no objection regarding joining the classes
3. All students will come with negative RT PCR report within 72 hours. Those who have no facility of RT PCR covid testing in their place will be tested here.
4. Students will report at 9: 30 AM in Darwar hall /adjoining ground for covid report screening, sensitization and awareness session
5. While waiting in Darwar hall/ground students will maintain proper social distancing
6. Only those hostelite will be permitted in the hostel on 30-11-2020 evening who have negative RT PCR and are coming by their own vehicles. Such students must intimate the hostel warden about their arrival a day before arrival. Students coming by public transport will have to undergo fresh RT PCR testing before entering into hostel.
7. Any student coming positive during screening will be isolated and will have to be quarantined as per guidelines ( home isolations/DCCC/DCHC/DCH)

8. If any student becomes covid positive during his stay in the institution will be managed on similar guidelines (home isolation/DCCC/DCHC/DCH)
9. Each student must bring adequate number of the following essential items :
  - Triple layered mask/ N95 masks
  - Hand sanitiser
  - Liquid soaps for personal use for frequent hand washing

## **DOS & DON'TS FOR STUDENTS:**

### **DOs:**

- Always wear a triple layered mask/ N95 while attending in person lectures, classes, laboratories, and the hospital or field for clinical postings.
